PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

URECO DEGREASER is a concentrated cleaner for floors, specially formulated to prepare concrete, metal, and other substrates prior to application of the Ureco Flooring Systems. Ureco Degreaser can be used in all types of sectors such as industrial, commercial, aeronautical, pharmaceutical and others. In addition, it meets the standards of the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) for use in food processing plants.

- Residential

DILUTION INSTRUCTIONS AND RATES

This product is a concentrated formulation. The dilution ratio may vary depending on the degree of contamination and the condition of the surface being treated. The dilution rate can range from 1:1 (1 part product to 1 part water) up to 1:25 (1 part product to 25 parts water), depending on surface porosity, texture, and level of contamination. As this product is supplied in concentrated form, always add the product **slowly into the water** when diluting — **never add water into the concentrate** — in order to **minimize the risk of hazardous splashing**. The concentrate should disperse gradually into a stable volume of water. Wear the required personal protective equipment (read safety data sheet) and mix gently until the solution is fully uniform.

APPLICATION

Wet the surfaces with plenty of water. Apply the product to the substrate and mechanically brush or scrub the surface. A standard floor scrubber equipped with a medium-duty pad (medium grit/strength) is suitable for this operation. A standard floor cleaning machine fitted with a medium (medium-strength) pad is appropriate.

After cleaning, rinse the surface with hot water until all foam has disappeared. Repeat the cleaning process as needed until contaminants are fully removed.

Remove any remaining water using a wet vacuum and accelerate drying with a fan or air mover. If required, complete drying using a medium-speed floor fan/ventilator.

STORAGE CONDITIONS

URECO DEGREASER must be stored dry between 5°C and 21°C. Do not store near open flame. The shelf life is 12 months from manufactured date in the original unopened container.

LIMITATIONS

DO NOT USE ON LINOLEUM, VINYL ASBESTOS, PAINT, OR FABRIC. A TEST PATCH IN A SECLUDED AREA IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED BEFORE APPLICATION!
